Guidelines for the passport and suitcase Groups 1 to 4


Preparation: Make sure you have sufficient advertising brochures.


Passports


- 1. Print the passport on an A4 sheet of paper.
- 2. Cut off the white print margin around the passport.
- 3. Fold the page over in the middle.
- 4. Glue the blank reverse sides to one another.
- 5. Fold the halved page once again in the middle.
- 6. The passport is ready to be filled in.

Two versions of the passport are available:

A full-colour version, with the front and back pages in colour (colour printer). A black-and-white version, with the front and back pages to be coloured in.







Suitcase

- 1. Print the suitcase out on an A4 sheet of paper.
- 2. Cut out the flags.
- 3. The children can colour in the flags and stick them on the suitcase.
- 4. Have the pupils cut out items from the advertising brochures that they would like to take on holiday with them (e.g. toothbrush, swimming trunks, etc.).
- 5. Have the pupils stick the items to the suitcase.

Two versions of the suitcase are available: A full-colour version, with the suitcase in colour (colour printer). A black-and-white version, with the suitcase and the flags to be coloured in.
